## Top 100 Defense Contractors 2022

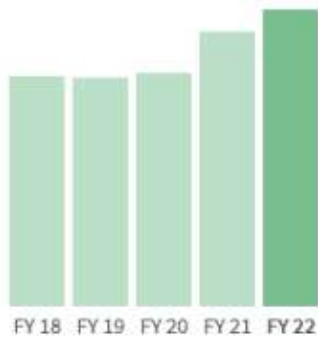
The following is a list of the Top 100 U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) prime contractors in fiscal year 2022 ranked by total contract funds awarded. The DoD had defense contract award obligations of [\\$423.9 billion in FY22](#), up 7 percent from [\\$395.7 billion in FY21](#). The top 100 FY22 contractors accounted for \$258.4 billion (61 percent) of the obligated dollars, compared to \$245.76 billion (62 percent) in FY21.

In FY22, the DoD's share of available funding was \$1.64 trillion, or 14.3 percent, of the FY22 U.S. federal budget. This is an increase of 8.6 percent compared to the DoD's share of the U.S. federal budget for FY21 of \$1.51 trillion, or 12.4 percent.

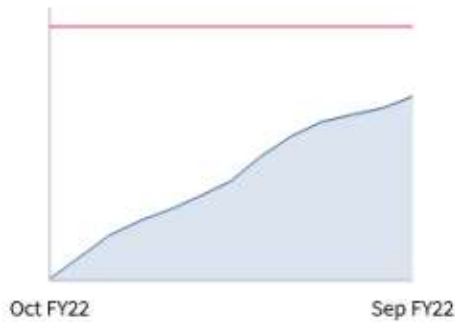
